



Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan (SRCSP) 21-22:

- School will begin on August 23, 2021.
- School will begin as a traditional school year with all students (100%) in attendance for full days, five days a week.

Mitigation Practices

- 3 ft social distancing
- Masks will be mandated for all students and adults.
- Handwashing and sanitizing will be taught and used regularly throughout the day.
- Respiratory Etiquette will be taught (using your elbow) and expected,
- Parents will review the home screening process with their children each day before coming to school.
- A school screening process for students and staff when they first arrive.
- A school walking "traffic flow" plan for movement within the building.
- We will conduct contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with the State and local health authorities when needed.
- We will work with State and local health authorities to provide access to vaccinations for all members of our community if they are eligible.
- We will have rapid tests for Covid-19 for use of students or staff.
- Cleaning regimens will be consistent with CDC guidelines.
- These strategies will have appropriate accommodations for children with disabilities in accordance with their IEP with respect to the health and safety policies.

Continuity of Services

- Students will take their chromebook home to access daily class through our Google Class system.
 - We will instruct students on the proper use of school technology and support their parents in accessing the learning we are providing.
 - We will provide internet access, as necessary.
 - Our teachers, school counselor, nurse, and administration will check-in with families to provide support including nutrition and health services.
